I. POLICY STATEMENT

This policy identifies the standards, responsibilities, and authority of the DCS Office of Licensing and Regulation (OLR) regarding pre-service and reinstatement requirements for licensed foster parents.

II. APPLICABILITY

This policy applies to all applicants seeking initial or a reinstated foster care license issued under the Arizona Administrative Code (A.A.C.) Title 21 Chapter 6 (Foster Home Licensing), licensing agencies, and the OLR staff responsible for reviewing foster home licensing applications.

IV. **DEFINITIONS**

Applicant: A potential foster parent and licensed foster parent.

<u>Department or DCS</u>: The Arizona Department of Child Safety

<u>Department of Child Safety-Foster Parent College</u> or <u>DCS-FPC</u>: The current DCS authorized pre-service curriculum. It is composed of four online "clusters" and five classroom sessions.

<u>Licensing Agency</u>: an entity, which may include a licensed Placing Agency that the Department contracts with to recruit and train foster parents and monitor a licensed foster home.

Management: Manager, Supervisor, or Designee.

Office of Licensing and Regulation (OLR): The administration within DCS that is responsible for reviewing and evaluating applications for licensure; supervising and monitoring licensees; and completing all official licensing actions, including issuing, denying, amending, suspending, and revoking a license.

V. POLICY

- A. The licensing agency of an applicant previously licensed as a foster parent in the state of Arizona shall:
 - 1. Contact OLR management regarding the status of the applicant's license at the time of license closure.
 - 2. Follow the training requirements table (attached) based on the applicant's specific training needs.
- B. The licensing agency shall work with an applicant who was previously a licensed foster parent in another state and obtain:
 - Proof of the applicant's licensure from that state. If unable to obtain proof, the applicant must take pre-service training as prescribed in <u>DCS 10-11</u> <u>Foster Parent Pre-Service Training</u>, the training requirements table

(attached), and submit an Adam Walsh background check to the state from which they were licensed.

- 2. The applicant's licensing file from the state.
- 3. The status of the applicant's license when the prior foster care license was closed.
- 4. Follow the guidelines set forth <u>DCS 10-11 Foster Parent Pre-Service Training</u> in the training requirements table (attached) based on the applicant's specific training needs.
- C. An applicant that completed Arizona Foster Care Pre-Service training as outlined in DCS 10-11 Foster Parent Pre-Service Training but did not obtain licensure shall complete the required training prescribed in DCS 10-11 Foster Parent Pre-Service Training and the training requirements table (attached).
- D. When the foster care application is received through the Department's Electronic Database, OLR will follow procedures for initial, or reinstatement of license, per DCS 15-12 Determining Licensing Effective Dates depending on the elapsed time between prior license closure and the new application date.
