

FIELD OPERATIONS OVERDUE REPORT REDUCTION STANDARD WORK

Standard Work for Field Operations Sections to Reduce Overdue Reports

Purpose: Standardize leadership accountability practice to review conditions causing overdue reports and supervisors to obtain closure commitments, when appropriate, on all reports 45+ days old, when the percentage of reports for a Section that have been open for 60+ days (Overdue) reaches a critical threshold.

Trigger: Percentage of Overdue Reports for a Section is above the target performance goal as determined by Leadership at the beginning of a week (target performance goal shall not exceed 17% of open reports in an overdue status).

Deliverables:

- 1. Program Manager to identify the unit(s) that most significantly impact the total number of overdue reports for the Section to obtain closure commitments, barriers, and approved conditions for overdue reports.
- 2. Program Supervisor to identify all cases 45+ days old to document commitments to resolve, or to provide Leadership with the reason that will cause the investigation to be overdue using the 45+ Check Sheet.
- 3. If report status for all cases is unknown, Program Supervisor to triage all cases 45+ days old with the Specialists for the purposes of providing investigation direction, obtaining the barrier, or setting an obtainable, and firm closure date using the 45+ Check Sheet. More than half of the closure commitments should be overdue reports.
- 4. Countermeasures should be created and added to the Unit Huddle Board Countermeasure sheet to improve investigation process when applicable.
- 5. Program Supervisor completes 45+ Check Sheet and provides a copy to Program Manager by 11 AM on Monday.
- 6. Program Manager approves and submits to Program Administrator by Noon on Monday.
- 7. Program Administrator submits aggregate data for weekly accountability call.
- 8. Program Supervisor provides updated 45+ Check Sheet with progress on closure commitments to Program Manager on the following Monday. If targets are missed update barriers to completion.
