

## NYTD Services LCH481 Matrix

Purpose: The NYTD Services matrix is intended to facilitate a conversation regarding the appropriate responses for CHILDS NYTD window LCH481. The NYTD window is completed at least once during each reporting period: Oct. 1<sup>st</sup>-March 31<sup>st</sup> and April 1<sup>st</sup>-Sept. 30<sup>th</sup>. Any youth who had a Chafee funded service needs a completed window (all youth in YAP units needs window completed). NYTD Services document “yes” responses ONLY for Chafee funded services by a DCS employee/placement, Arizona’s Children Association life skills/TILP/Thrive mentoring or Education and Training Voucher (ETV).

X=answer “no” if youth didn’t receive service AND if they did receive service but it is provided by RBHA, AFFCF, Bridging Success, Vocational Rehabilitation or any non-Chafee funded service. ✓=answer “yes” if indicated as applicable below or if it’s service related, service is provided by a Chafee funded contract: DCS placement, Arizona’s Children Association life skills training/TILP/Thrive mentoring, Education and Training Voucher (ETV)

Foster Care Status	<b>YES:</b> Youth was under 18 during the reporting period. <b>NO:</b> Youth was over 18 during the entire reporting period.
Tribal Affiliation: eligible or enrolled	<b>YES:</b> Documentation required for Tribal membership. <b>NO:</b> Youth not eligible or enrolled.
Ever been adjudicated delinquent	<b>YES:</b> Youth must be found adjudicated delinquent by the court with supporting documentation (court minute entry, court report, etc). Probation does not necessarily equal adjudication. <b>NO:</b> Youth has never been found an adjudicated delinquent.
Highest grade completed	Answer the highest level COMPLETED by the youth. Must have documentation in the file to support. If GED is completed, still mark highest level of schooling completed.
Special Education: Active IEP/504	<b>YES:</b> Active IEP/504 plan for the student, documentation in file. <b>NO:</b> Youth not receiving services.
Independent Living Needs Assessment: Casey Life skills assessment	<b>YES:</b> Documentation of CLSA or another appropriate assessment, provided by a DCS contracted service (AzCA, DCS placement, ETV). <b>NO:</b> Youth didn't receive assessment.
Academic Support: High School/GED	<b>YES:</b> Documentation in file shows that a DCS contracted service (AzCA, DCS placement, ETV) taught or assisted youth with academic support for high school or GED attainment. <b>NO:</b> Youth did not receive service.
Post-secondary educational support	<b>YES:</b> Documentation in file shows that a DCS contracted service (AzCA, DCS placement, ETV) taught or assisted youth with academic support for post-secondary or vocational training. <b>NO:</b> Youth did not receive service.
Career Preparation	<b>YES:</b> Documentation in file shows that a DCS contracted service (AzCA, DCS placement, ETV) assisted youth with career preparation. <b>NO:</b> Youth did not receive service.
Employment or vocational program	This answer is always <b>NO</b> as AZ does not have any DCS or Chafee funded Vocational or employment programs.
Budget and Financial Management	<b>YES:</b> Documentation in file shows that a DCS contracted service (AzCA, DCS placement, ETV) taught or assisted youth with budget and financial management. <b>NO:</b> Youth did not receive service.
Housing and home management	<b>YES:</b> Documentation in file shows that a DCS contracted service (AzCA, DCS placement, ETV) taught or assisted youth with housing or home management. <b>NO:</b> Youth did not receive service.
Health education and risk prevention	<b>YES:</b> Documentation in file shows that a DCS contracted service (AzCA, DCS placement, ETV) taught or assisted youth with health education and risk prevention. <b>NO:</b> Youth did not receive service.
Family support and healthy marriage education	<b>YES:</b> Documentation in file shows that a DCS contracted service (AzCA, DCS placement, ETV) taught or assisted youth with family support/health marriage education. <b>NO:</b> Youth did not receive service.
Mentoring	<b>YES:</b> Youth has mentor through AzCA-Thrive. <b>NO:</b> Youth doesn't have mentor through AzCA-Thrive.
Supervised Independent Living	<b>YES:</b> Y.A. is over 18 and in DCS Subsidy program, TILP, living in dorm paid for with ETV. <b>NO:</b> Y.A. is in DCS paid placement.
Room and board financial assistance	<b>YES:</b> Y.A. is over 18 and received financial payment through paid placement, Subsidy, TILP, ETV for room and board. <b>NO:</b> Youth did not receive funding for room and board.
Educational Financial Assistance	<b>YES:</b> Payment provided to youth for activities/fees for secondary or post-secondary education: tuition, books, testing, etc. <b>NO:</b> Youth did not receive funding for educational assistance.
Other financial assistance	<b>YES:</b> Y.A. received financial services that don't meet any of the above categories: driving school, normalcy activities, work clothing, etc. <b>NO:</b> Youth did not receive other financial assistance.
